

How Can I Become A Christian?

1. Read Daniel 10:1-21

2. What insight from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening, or troubling? Explain.

3. What is Daniel burdened by in verses 1-3? What effect does the burden have on him?

4. How does Daniel describe the angel who appeared to him in a vision? How does he respond? (vv 4-9)

5. What do the angel's words to Daniel tell you about God's response to those who seek him? (vv 10-14)

6. How did the angel describe Daniel's reputation with God? (vv 11, 19)

7. What do the following verses tell you about our reputation, position, and standing with God? How does knowing these things impact your prayer life?

John 15:15

Romans 8:14-17

Ephesians 1:3-14

1 Peter 2:9-10

8. The "prince of the Persian kingdom" (v 13) who resisted God's messenger probably refers to a powerful evil spirit who influenced the affairs of the Persian government. What does this "unveiling" of demonic activity in political affairs teach you about our world?

11. What experiences have you had that you believe fit in the category of spiritual warfare? How do you discern if a difficult circumstance is just "life happening" or if it is evidence of spiritual warfare?

12. How long did it take for Daniel to get an answer to his prayer for understanding regarding the vision he had seen? (vv 2, 13). How does this experience encourage you to be persistent in prayer?

13. What do we learn about angels from this passage?
