

## THE SOVEREIGNTY OF GOD

1 Chronicles 29:10-13; Romans 11:33-36

**Main Thought:** The fact that God is in control of all things has practical implications for our lives.

### 1. WHAT SOVEREIGNTY MEANS

- 1) God is greater than and exists above his creation.  
(1 Kings 8:27; Eph. 4:6)
- 2) God never needs permission or help.  
(Acts 17:25; Romans 9:20)
- 3) God can do anything He wants.  
(Job 42:2; Psalm 147:4-5)

### 2. PRACTICAL IMPLICATIONS OF GOD'S SOVEREIGNTY

- 1) Because God is in control, my plans have a limit.  
(James 4:13-15)
  
- 2) Because God is in control, my problems have a purpose. (James 1:2-4; Romans 8:28)
  
- 3) Because God is in control, my prayers have an impact. (1 Thess. 5:17; Matt. 7:7-8; Eph. 3:20)
